555th ANNIVERSARY:

This Sunday within the Octave of the Feast of the Ascension marks the 555th anniversary of the building of our Church in 1467 by Duncan Napier the Laird of Kilmahew. On that day it was consecrated by Bishop Lauder of Argyll, with the permission of Bishop Muirhead of Glasgow in whose Bishopric it was situated. The chapel was restored in 1955 on the Sunday within the Octave of the Ascension by Archbishop Campbell of our Archdiocese who sang Pontifical High Mass to inaugurate its renewed existence as a centre of Catholic life.
